Elijah Heard “a still small voice”

1 Kings 19:12 (NKJV)

Isaiah 30:21 (NKJV)

Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, “This *is* the way, walk in it,” Whenever you turn to the right hand Or whenever you turn to the left.

Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others judge.

1 Thessalonians 5:20-21 (NKJV)

Do not despise prophecies. Test all things; hold fast what is good.

Acts 21:8-14 (NKJV)

On the next *day* we who were Paul's companions departed and came to Caesarea, and entered the house of Philip the evangelist, who was *one* of the seven, and stayed with him. Now this man

had four virgin daughters who prophesied. And as we stayed many days, a certain prophet named Agabus came down from Judea. When he had come to us, he took Paul's belt, bound his *own* hands and feet, and said, "Thus says the Holy Spirit, 'So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man who owns this belt, and deliver *him* into the hands of the Gentiles.' " Now when we heard these things, both we and those from that place pleaded with him not to go up to Jerusalem. Then Paul answered, "What do you mean by weeping and breaking my heart? For I am ready not only to be bound, but also to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus." So when he would not be persuaded, we ceased, saying, "The will of the Lord be done."
